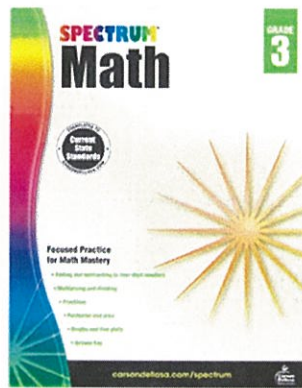


Summer Math for Rising 3rd Graders

Dear Families,

To maintain math skills over the summer and prevent the “summer slide,” Lower School teachers are sharing some summer math practice with all students. Spectrum Math Grade 3 [Spectrum Math Grade 3](#) has been carefully selected for rising 3rd grade students.



Chapters 1 - 3, 6, and 9 are recommended as reinforcement of skills learned in second grade. Chapters 4, 5, 7, and 8 also provide extra practice, but include concepts that may not have been introduced and/or fully mastered.

A few items to note:

- **RECOMMENDED** - Summer math practice will not be graded by the teacher. This is not required, but it is highly recommended. Answers/solutions are provided in the back of the book to check for understanding and to use as a tool to identify areas that may need improvement or additional practice. This is not something that has to be completed in its entirety, and isn't intended for everyday usage, but a little practice throughout the course of the summer is sure to make a difference in the start to the new school year.
- **REQUIRED** - It is required that all students practice and know their addition/subtraction facts 0 -20 to begin the school year. We expect 100% mastery of addition/subtraction fact fluency by the start of 3rd grade.
