

Recommended Summer Math Practice for Rising 4th Graders

Dear Parents and Students,

In an effort to maintain math skills over the summer and prevent the “summer slide,” we are sharing some summer math practice with all students. Spectrum Math (which all students already have) has been carefully chosen by Mrs. Combs for rising 4th grade students. Chapters 1 – 5 are recommended as reinforcement of skills learned in third grade.

Chapters 6 – 9 also provide extra practice, but include concepts that may not have been fully mastered.

A few items to note:

- **RECOMMENDED** - Summer math practice will not be graded by the teacher. This is not required, but it is highly recommended. Answers/solutions are provided in the back of the book to check for understanding and to use as a tool to identify areas that may need improvement or additional practice. This is not something that has to be done in its entirety, and isn't intended for everyday usage, but a little practice along the way is sure to make a difference to start the new school year.
- **REQUIRED** - It is required that all students practice and know their multiplication facts 0 – 12 to begin the school year. We expect 100% mastery for fact fluency in the 4th grade.
